



Princeton University is the process of completing the relocation of their recreational tennis facilities to the vicinity of the Varsity program tennis courts.

As part of the project, 9 recreational courts were sited in two batteries with a historical Pavilion relocated in between. South of these batteries, 3 hard courts and three soft courts were built to serve the Alumni.

The next Phase of work shall include the addition and reconstruction of the Varsity Courts; 12 in all. Three of the courts shall be shared with the recreation program, while 9 courts shall be arranged on either side of an elevated grandstand and joined to a new Varsity Alumni House.

In all, 27 tennis courts will be available to all parts of the Princeton University community.
